Saturday, September 27, 2008 – Peck Sink Preserve Cleanup. Meet at 8:00 AM at the new gate at the southeast corner of the property on Wiscon Road, just west of Mobley Road. Work will be completed by noon. Volunteers should bring gloves, insect repellent, sun screen, drinking water, and a five gallon bucket or other container for collecting trash. This workday will be held in cooperation with National Public Lands Day and the Ocean Conservancy's International Coastal Cleanup.

Thursday, October 16, 2008 – Peck Sink Preserve Cleanup. Meet at 9:00 AM at the new gate at the southeast corner of the property on Wiscon Road, just west of Mobley Road. Work will be completed by noon. Volunteers should bring gloves, insect repellent, sun screen, drinking water, and a five gallon bucket or other container for collecting trash.

Saturday, November 15, 2008 –Fickett Hammock Preserve Hiking Trail Creation and/or Fence Row Clearing. Meet at 8:00 AM at the parking lot at 15482 Centralia Road (just west of Citrus Way).
